### Emissions reduction targets

In order to continue our progress to achieving Net Zero, we have adopted the following carbon reduction targets. While Cloudbreak Analysis anticipates significant business growth, we remain committed to achieving net-zero by 2050. Our strategy focuses on reducing emissions intensity, even as our operations scale.

We project that carbon emissions will increase over the next five years as we travel more to deliver our increased project load, but we will continue to offset our Carbon footprint and to implement our strategies to reduce the Carbon spend from what it might be.

### Carbon Reduction Projects

#### Completed Carbon Reduction Initiatives

The following environmental management measures and projects have been completed or implemented since the 2019 baseline. The carbon emission reduction achieved by these schemes equate to 273.90 tCO<sub>2</sub>e, a 100%ge reduction against the 2024 baseline and the measures will be in effect when performing the contract

- We have been offsetting our carbon via Carbon Neutral Britain since 2019; we are certified as carbon neutral.
- We offer a preferential rate for e-learning and virtual training delivery to encourage clients to favour those delivery methods which reduce our Carbon due to reduced overseas travel.

In the future we hope to implement further measures such as:

- Running most of our team meetings virtually
- Encouraging clients to consider virtual and e-learning training options and providing feedback to them on Carbon emissions saved in doing so.


This Carbon Reduction Plan has been completed in accordance with PPN 06/21 and associated guidance and reporting standard for Carbon Reduction Plans.
